

# ***Packing List & Suggestions***

**\*\*\*Reminder - There is a 85lbs. baggage weight limit per person unless otherwise arranged.\*\***

## **PERSONAL ITEMS:**

- Medications (ibuprofen, acetaminophen, allergy, antacids)
  - Prescription medications
  - Vitamins
  - Shampoo and conditioner
  - Toothbrush and toothpaste
  - Mouthwash
  - Hairbrush and comb
  - Razor and extra blades
  - Body lotion
  - Lip balm
  - Unscented sunscreen
  - Deodorant
  - Insect repellent
  - Pre-moistened towelettes
  - Shaving cream
  - Small flashlight
  - Ear plugs
  - Sun glasses
  - Camera and batteries
- \*\*Personal items may be purchased at the Camp Store if forgotten\*\***

## **DOCUMENTATION AND ESSENTIALS:**

- Photo ID, driver's license, birth certificate
- ON Outdoors Card and fishing license
- Passport (for border crossing)
- Wallet, cash and traveler's checks
- Extra prescription glasses or contact lenses.

## **CLOTHING:**

- Shirts (t-shirts, sweatshirts, cotton shirts, flannel shirts)
- Underwear (thermal underwear, if cooler weather)
- Cotton socks, wool socks
- Pants, jeans, shorts
- Belt
- Close toed shoes, sandals, rainboots, slippers
- Breathable rain suit
- Hats for sun and rain
- Windproof jacket
- Gloves
- Swim wear

## **FISHING GEAR:**

(if bringing your own)

- Fishing rods
- Rod holder (for vehicle)
- Fillet knife
- Knife sharpener
- Hand-held GPS (optional)
- Elastic bands for packing rods on aircraft
- Stringer
- Needle-nose pliers
- Spare spools
- Fishing gloves
- Extra reel with rod repair kit
- Matches

## **SUGGESTED TACKLE**

### **LAKE TROUT:**

- Medium weight rod/spinning reel
- 14 – 20lb test line
- Artificial/power bait
- 4" – 6" weedless spoons
- 9" – 12" steel leaders
- A

### **NORTHERN PIKE:**

- Heavy action rod with 14lb test line
- Sutton spoons
- North port nailers
- Flutter spoons
- Dipsey divers
- Little Cleos 3 - 4"
- 1-1/2oz jigs with 3-4" white tube tails
- 3-way swivels and snap swivels
- Assorted crank bait
- Spinners

### **• WALLEYE:**

- Light weight rod/spinning reel
- 4-8 lbs test line
- 1/4 - 1/2 oz. jig heads in assorted colours
- 1/4 to 1/8 oz. weights and sinkers
- Artificial powerbait
- 3" - 8" assorted crank bait
- 6' - 9" nylon leaders

# ***Packing Tips***

- Please combine your fishing rods into one or two rod cases, or wrap rods in rubber bands for small, easy to transport packages. Rod cases over 6 feet are not permitted, but longer rods are allowed. Please take the reel off the rod for a more compact package. You may be asked to take your rods out of the case for the flight to the Lodge, if space in the airplane is limited.
- Pack your gear in small or medium sized duffel bags so they can be stored under the seat during flight. Several small packages are easier to load/store than one very large one.
- Please do not use hard sided suitcases with wheels. Soft suitcases may be used.
- Pack one tackle box. Tackle boxes should weight no more than 20 lbs. Coordinate with your group which items can be shared.
- Keep a cigarette lighter in your tackle box, even if you don't smoke.
- There are specific weight restrictions for our aircraft, for each flight. Our trips are based on flights that allow a generous **85 lbs. of personal equipment per person**. This includes all of your gear for the duration of your stay. Sometimes a little planning and advance weighing of your gear at home can save time sorting at the dock. Also remember, you can pre-order pop and beverages.
- Flights for extra gear will be done once all guests for that day are moved. There may be an additional cost if no other flights are scheduled for the lodge that day.

**Note:** Although we fly in beverages that are ordered for no extra charge, we are not obligated to fly beverages back on return trip. Please plan accordingly.

**Note:** If you would to pre-order special items as well, please reach out to us for additional information.

**Note:** If you have dietary restrictions, please let us know at least a week in advance, so we can have the appropriate food at the Lodge for you.
