

# MOOSE HUNT PACKING LIST

## **PERSONAL ITEMS:**

- Medications (ibuprofen, acetaminophen, allergy, antacids)
- Prescription medications - make sure to pack enough for seven extra days
- Prescription glasses or contact lenses
- Vitamins
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Deodorant
- Unscented sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Pre-moistened towelettes
- Sleeping bag, pillow, towel

## **DOCUMENTATION AND ESSENTIALS:**

- Passport (for border crossing)
- Photo ID (drivers' license etc.)
- Ontario Outdoors Card and license summary
- Cash and checks for payment and gratuities

## **CLOTHING:**

- Shirts for layering (t-shirts, sweatshirts, cotton shirts, flannel shirts)
- Thermal underwear
- Cotton socks, wool socks
- Pants, jeans
- Footwear - lightweight, waterproof boots for walking; warm, insulated boots; rubber boots; slip-on shoes for inside tent or cabin
- Good quality rainwear
- Hip-waders
- Warm hat and coat
- Gloves, mitts
- Hunter Orange vest and hat (minimum of 400 sq. inches)

## **HUNTING GEAR:**

- Rifle (please make sure your rifle is sighted prior to arrival)
- Soft rifle case for transportation on the aircraft
- Two boxes of shells with gun (180 grain is most popular)
- Walkie Talkies (minimum 20k range)
- Ziplock bags (for licenses and tags)
- Binoculars (for gauging longer shots)
- GPS or compass
- InReach compact satellites allow for text messaging and access to weather and maps
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Hunting knife/fish fileting knife
- Four large coolers per moose - expect around 400 to 800 lbs. of dressed meat. Some hunters bring a freezer to be plugged in at our water base at the end of the week

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### **FISHING GEAR:**

- Fishing rods
- Rod holder (for vehicle)
- Knife sharpener
- Stringer
- Needle-nose pliers
- Spare spools
- Fishing gloves
- Extra reel with rod repair kit
- Matches
